

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of Harlowton Yard Foreman D. K. Bundren, Helpers A. E. Massing and D. D. Minder for minimum yard day lost on July 2, 1974; Foreman D.K. Bundren, Helpers K. R. Hill and L. A. Berg and D. J. Blumhagen for August 29, 1974, account Roundhouse employees unloading gravel within the confines of the Roundhouse.

FINDINGS: On each of the dates of claim these yard crews complain that roundhouse employees at Harlowton were used to spread gravel around roundhouse tracks. This is not work exclusively reserved to yard employees by the Agreement. Furthermore, Article 27, cited by the Union, will not support a sustaining award.

AWARD: Claim denied.
