STATEMENT "SR&B Seniority District (Buffalo) Conductor T. A.
OF Ervolina, Brakemen M. W. McMahon and R. G. Wydro
CLAIM: for one day, yard rate, account performing yard
service while regularly assigned to road service
on September 5, 1969.

FINDINGS:

This Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence finds that: the employee or employees and carrier involved in this dispute are respectively employee and carrier within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act as amended; that this Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein, and the parties to said dispute were given due notice of hearing thereon.

Claimants, while in Road Service, were instructed to assist train BM-10 from Colvin Street, Buffalo to Frontier Yard, all within the switching limits of Buffalo Terminal. SBA No. 387, in its Award No. 56, recognized that work within yard switching limits is yard service. The Board will follow that decision and sustain the claim.


AWARD: Claim sustained.
