

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim for a day's pay for Switchmen J. N. Logan, L. E. Donohue and J. L. Beringer for July 27, 1981, because Lead Crew #1 was annulled and replaced by Trim Crew #2.

FINDINGS: This Public Law Board No. 1906 finds that the parties herein are Carrier and Employee within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as amended, and that this Board has jurisdiction.

The facts in this dispute are similar to those in Award No. 291 of this Board. The Board has carefully examined all the facts and circumstances and concludes that the ruling in Award No. 291 should be controlling in this case.


AWARD: Claim denied.
