Parties to Dispute:

UNITED TRANSPORTATION UNION (C&T)
and
MISSOURI PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY

Statement of Claim:

"Claims of various yard crews, various dates for one yard day each date account violation of yard assignment agreement."

Opinion of Board:

Claimants were assigned to Job 216A, "Switches at Kaw Bridge, industry work, first transfer and other duties."

Job 203A was described to: "Switches industries in zones 1-3, 1-4, 1-7, and other duties."

On claim dates the 203 job performed certain transfer service.


Transfer service was cars in Carrier's custody and moved from one area to another within the terminal. It is not necessarily transfer to a foreign carrier.

Findings: That the agreement was violated.

AWARD: Claim sustained.

Carrier is directed to make this award effective on or before 30 days from date.
