STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

Claim of PTCO Condr N. M. Brink, Yardmen R. R. Bissonette and M. H. Lyden dated January 23, 1978, for one day account called for "puller" service, instructed by GYM to do general yard switching service, went back into puller service and worked beyond 8 hours.

FINDINGS:

This Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds as follows:

That the parties were given due notice of the hearing;

That the Carrier and Employees involved in this dispute are respectively Carrier and Employees within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein.

On January 23, 1978, the Claimants were called to perform "puller service" at Rigby Yard. The "puller service" entailed moving cars from one track to another to enable a spreader to remove snow. After the snow was removed, the crew was required to return the cars to their original location. The Claimants reported for work and proceeded to perform the "puller service," the assignment for which they were specifically called. However, in addition to that service, the Yardmaster instructed the crew to perform general yard switching. When the general yard switching was completed, the Yardmaster instructed the crew to continue performing "puller service." The Claimants thereafter performed "puller service" until their tour of duty was completed.

Alleging that they were required to perform two (2) classes of service in violation of Article 40, Section (a) of the Yardmen's Agreement, the Claimants submitted the instant claim for one (1) day's pay each.


The pertinent facts and positions of the parties in this claim are essentially similar to those presented to this Board in Award No. 61. Based on the reasoning expressed by this Board in Award No. 61, the instant claim shall be denied.

AWARD:


Claim denied.
