Statement  
of Claim: Claim of Conductor R. C. Tilstra, S. Gorsage and R. Stevenson  
claiming 100 miles account picking up car at Monticello and  
Reynolds without switch list.


Findings: The Board, after hearing upon the whole record and all  
evidence, finds that the parties herein are Carrier and Employee within  
the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as amended, that this Board is  
duly constituted by Agreement dated March 26, 1980, that it has  
jurisdiction of the parties and the subject matter, and that the parties  
were given due notice of the hearing held.

The facts giving rise to the instant claim and the principles  
involved are the same or so similar to be indistinguishable from those  
presented in Claim No. 2 and 10 resulting in Awards 2 and 10 and for the  
reasons announced therein, this claim, likewise, will be denied.
